

Setting up a Standing Order for NMSCC membership

Thank you for opting to pay for membership by standing order. Please complete the form below and send to your bank. Alternatively use the club's account details to pay by bank transfer using internet banking.
To complete the form:

1. Insert your bank title and address.
2. Indicate frequency: you can opt to pay £40 annually or £10 quarterly (for OAPs £20 annually or £5 quarterly). Enter the date payment is to start. (You may stop the standing order at any time by instructing your bank).
3. Complete your account details, sign and date. Send the completed form to your bank.
4. Ensure that you send me your completed membership form and please indicate if you have set up a standing order.
